Equality	Some people may need extra help to get the same

	The Equality Act 2010 is a law to make sure all people are treated fairly.
	The <b>Equality Duty</b> tells us how we should think about how our work supports equality. For example, in our services, through our jobs and through the money we spend.
	Duty means the things we must do.

	Discrimination means treating people differently from others. For example, leaving you out of a group because you have a disability.
	Harassment is a kind of behaviour that annoys or upsets someone. It can be visual, verbal, and physical.
You're a !#%^i*	<b>Bullying</b> is when people treat you in a bad way. Doing things like calling you names or being physically or verbally violent.
	<b>Protected characteristics</b> are things to do with a person, like age, race, religion, disability, being a man or a woman, marriage, pregnancy.
	<b>Disadvantages / Disadvantaged</b> is when you have a problem or difficulty that many other people do not have, which makes it harder for you to do well.

	1. To protect people from <b>discrimination</b> , <b>harassment</b> , <b>bullying</b> and any other behaviours not allowed by the Act.
	2. To make sure things are equal for everyone and everyone has the same chances in life.
	3. To make sure there are good relationships between people who share a <b>protected</b>
	characteristic and people who do not share it.
	Such as age, disability, race, gender, religion and so on.
	There are other groups who also suffer
	<b>disadvantages</b> . We need to think about their needs also.

	<ul> <li>This includes:</li> <li>those in poverty</li> <li>rural isolation</li> <li>those who have been in care</li> <li>homelessness</li> <li>those who have served in the Armed Forces</li> <li>people who are unemployed</li> <li>carers</li> </ul>
