(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
ORDER 20--

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to:

Prohibit waiting in the Parish of St Ives

Street Name	Side of Road	Lengths
North Street	Both sides	from a point 42 metres east of its junction with Ramsey Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 106 metres
East Street	South side	from its junction with Crown Mews in an easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres
Station Road	South side	from a point 20 metres west of its junction with New Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres

The draft Order, together with a map showing the roads and lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the office of the undersigned and at the office of Cambridgeshire Highways, Stanton Way, Stukeley Meadows Industrial Estate, Huntingdon PE29 6PY during normal office hours.
