# Compliments April 2022 – March 2023

<u>All</u> compliments passed to the Children's Complaints and Feedback Team are presented here. They are divided into compliments from young people, parents, other family members and foster carers; compliments from professionals independent of Children's Services; and compliments from members of staff with no line management oversight of the individual cases. They have been anonymised both in terms of the children and families concerned, and also in terms of those individual members of staff being praised. Otherwise, compliments are presented below exactly as they were received.

# Parent(s) said of Family Worker

Although this email may seem incredibly late I've struggled to find the right words to write to be able to express quite how much of an impact that J had on our family unit - no words have seemed enough to thank her for the work she did.

J was assigned to my family after some troubled exchanges between us and Cambridgeshire County Council, we were in a desperate situation, overwhelmed, lost in a system, parenting a child with unknown needs and struggling to cope with a potential diagnosis of Autism and a learning disability for our eldest daughter X. We were quite literally wandering around in the dark with no focus, scared, afraid of doing the wrong thing, not knowing what was the right path. The relationship between X and myself was one where I had lost all confidence as a mum, I felt I'd got it wrong for so long that I didn't know what was right and guite frankly I was scared of it all. Scared of trying to set boundaries, scared of doing the wrong thing, scared of taking control as I felt I'd got it all wrong up to this point. In walked J - from the moment she entered our home she was strong, positive and confident. The confidence I lacked and was so desperate to find again. J's persona was kind, caring, understanding and so much more - she listened, more than anyone had done.J explained we couldn't change the past and together we had the tools to change things around for the better. I immediately felt safe in J's presence, comforted by her strength and lead and as though, after so so long, we had someone that actually got us! All the way through J's involvement she made time for me, even when her schedule was hectic. She would always return my calls or text me to let me know that although she couldn't speak at that time she would be in contact by the end of the day. There was never a time where she made me feel anything other than listened to, J always gave advice even when sometimes as a parent it was difficult to hear.... And I think that was the key, J never sugar coated anything, she was always honest, clear and concise and if it was something she didn't know the answer to she would always seek advice and come back to me with an answer. It was clear from the start J was incredibly good at her job role and that she shared a passion for families and getting things back on track.... Towards the end of our time together this became even more apparent. Although J's job role was detailed as a "family worker" she is so much more than just that. J is strength, positivity, calm, determined, comforting, caring, fun, caring, fantastic

with children, amazing with mums (and dads!), not afraid to tell things as they are but also always offer a solution. We were having an issue with X and her lack of respect for boundaries- One line that always sticks with me Was when J said "You're a mum, your position is to create boundaries for the sake of X - those friends do not need to come in to you house and eat your food that you pay for until X can respect your rules" I must of looked terrified at the thought of having to try and break the cycle that we are in, J immediately recognised this and said "Come on X, you know you need to do this, and it's ok to make the rules - enough is enough, don't give excuses, just tell X, the kids and the parents about the decision you've made until Further notice". It's ok to make the rules.... It's ok to make the rules!!! And I did!! I made a stand, it went ok and the issue stopped! J was right - confidence! J didn't only support us as a family but she was a huge support for me, more than I can convey in words. Whilst J liaised with schools, young persons workers, education inclusion officers and more she also made time for me as a mum. We spoke about me, she gave me words of comfort, she told me about personal experiences, we spoke of our families, about dealing with a child with additional needs... we spoke about a lot of heavy stuff, but we also laughed! That laughter was invaluable, it made me realise that J was more than a family worker - she was a mum, a wife and a person with similar experiences.

When we knew J was coming to the end of her time with us we joked about how much longer we could try and keep her for, she was a staple in my week, an appointment i looked forward to, an hour where I could be any thing I needed to be - happy, sad, in tears, laughing, asking for advice, discussing a battle plan, putting in boundaries, helping me deal with 3 other children, discussing health, mental health, exercise, weight loss, confidence, you name it I think we discussed it at some point.... Even popping out to the garden with the children to bask in the sunshine - my happy place.

So, Christmas came and J's work had ended, it was a tearful goodbye and I felt incredibly emotional at loosing her, the support she provided but also the huge part J had played in my life as the mum of a child with additional needs - now formally diagnosed as Autism, a learning disability and ADHD. I honestly don't know the words to write to show just how much J meant to us, to convey that she's so so much more than just a family worker. My experience with J was invaluable, essential and enjoyable. Any family that is lucky enough to have J assigned to them will succeed, because she wouldn't have it any other way! I still miss our weekly meetings, prepping the coffee ready for a huge sigh as we take our places on the sofa.... The relationship between J and the cat!!

J had such a profound effect on our family and learning to parent a child with additional needs, even more of an effect on me as a mum and a person - she will always have a very special place in my heart and my home. The words "thank you" aren't enough. I hope J gets the recognition that she deserves within her role as a family worker but also smiles at the way In which she changed our lives.

# Parent(s) said of Family Worker

We wanted to say a few words about C, which we hope will gain her some recognition for her work with us.

When we met C in June 2021 we were in a really low place. Our son (age 3 at the time) had been excluded from Nursery due to his behaviour. We knew something wasn't right and we were very worried about him and his future. My husband and I were stressed and possibly a bit depressed. The atmosphere in the house was tense. We weren't spending time together as a family - instead we were operating a tag-team system where 1 adult looked after X while the other looked after X.

Today is a very different story. Since working with C we have established a huge network of professional support around our son We are much happier as a family and we are spending much more time together. My husband and I are also in a much better place - enjoying each other once again and looking forward to the future.

I just wanted to email to explain how the support from L has impacted our family and our lives as it cannot be underestimated. After so many doors were shut in our faces and no support available to us L was the lifeline we so desperately needed.

The support and advice that L has provided to us has been instrumental in helping to heal and give our family the resilience it needs.

L just understands what life is like for parents with children with disabilities and her empathy and non judgmental approach enables you to feel less alone.

We were in a very bad and dark place as a family when L began to support us and she closes off leaving us in a completely different place.

Her knowledge is so extensive and she makes you feel that you can move forward in a better way as she is so positive and constantly comes up with new ideas and suggestions. She was flexible working around all our different times needs and just having one person who cared and wanted to help made all the difference to us.

We will miss her input but we know she has changed things so much that we can now cope and manage much better in her absence which is huge.

She came into our home and instantly made us feel at ease. K was non-judgemental, kind and made it clear from the very beginning that all she wanted to do was help my son and our family as much as she possibly could. She listened to everything I had to say, when I had a moan and when I shed tears. She happily involved grandparents who are big part of our family unit when they also expressed their concerns. But most importantly she was fantastic with my son who wanted to play and make friends; and despite his speech problem, K spent time with him and made an impression on him every time .

Initially my son was declined support from community services but K amended his initial referral and presented all the concerns directly. He has since had assessments with some professionals and more to come; all before he starts school in September.

Thanks to K I felt understood and supported in getting the help my son needs, when previously I felt very isolated and ignored. K could not of been more helpful, holding a TAF meeting before the school year ended giving me the opportunity to raise my concerns with school before he even starts. The reassurance that meeting gave me was immeasurable. Thanks to K I feel positive about the future for my little boy, both with starting his school journey and beyond.

We could not be more grateful and please pass this thanks on to K again.

For M's manager, I just wanted to give you some feedback on my time with M. I was really nervous to have M visit us as I knew her a little from nusery and Ive never had any help with the children and was worried what she may think.

Within very little time M had reassured me and made me feel at ease with her. Ive always felt like abit of a nusense but as my situation quickly got worse I was contacted M for advice quite often. M could understand my situation better than I could and responded to me phone calls promptly reassuring me that I wasnt a nusense and that it was a good thing to ask for help. M picked up on the fact myself and the children had been abused in different ways very quickly, after being married for 17years I was unaware of the emotional abuse I had suffered , M was very tactful in the way she made me realise what was right and wrong. M was great with all of my children and understood their needs. M was again was tactful in the way she helped me see what I needed to do to help the children. M has honestly helped change my life, although my time with her was not long, M really opened my eyes, she gave me so much help and support and knew that she needed to gradually tell me what was happening as wouldve found it hard to handle in one go. Life is up and down for us at the minute but we have so much help and support to start a new life. I will be forever grateful to M for helping me take that big leap, its scary but I can already see positive changes in the children. I will miss M, she is amazing at her job.

I didn't catch all of their names but I know one was called D. there were four ladies on the day who organised all of the families and coaches.

I wanted to email to say how wonderful your team are! they were spot on, registers, first aid kits, chatty and friendly, one of the coaches was late even. It was extremely rainy on the day and only got heavier throughout the day. They took everything in their stride, they were positive and adaptive.

Me and the children had such an excellent day! These trips that are provided by the family centre are so needed! Without a booked coach trip my children would not have had the luxury of visiting Thetford forest on their 6 week holiday. Without the funding provided we may have not been able to afford such a trip, but for £2.00 per person it really does take the barriers away to getting to and from and affording the trip.

The benefits to the parents that don't drive is untold. I am completely grateful. Every single year I feel guilty because I am not able to take my children places without relying on public transport and taxis (too expensive) every year I feel some amount of "parental failure and guilt" because I've never passed a driving test and cannot give my children the same privileges other children have with driving parents.

I was so impressed I felt it is important that you receive and email regarding how amazing your team are, and how essential the service they provide is to non-driving parents. The children will remember their day at Thetford for a long time and so will I. Once again thank you to the team at the Oasis family and children's centre.

Please consider this email if your team has things like end of year appraisals and or performance reviews. I really feel that the hard work they put in should be recognised in some way.

I am writing to tell you how helpful A and his team have been in meeting the needs of our 10 year old Ukrainian boy with complex special needs.

X and his mum arrived in the UK at the end of April, fleeing the war to live with us under the Homes for Ukraine scheme. X is living with autism, ADHD and is non verbal. We applied for an EHCP immediately and the only supporting evidence available was a medical report diagnosing autism in Ukrainian dated 2020.

A responded immediately, providing X with 12 hours a week home tuition within 2 weeks of their arrival and support from his advisory team, especially around communication.

Last week we attended X's transition meeting into school. The EHCP process was completed within 3.5 months and the appropriate provision sourced.

We are so grateful to A. His creativity and resourcefulness have ensured that this traumatised young boy will have a settled educational experience that meets his complex needs from now on.

His father has now been able to join the family here and they are already looking for accommodation. A's efforts have contributed hugely to getting this family on their feet. I have thanked him often, but want you to know the difference his work has made to this family.

L pointed out that there are risks for the child whichever direction I go and there is a perhaps a degree of pessimism about her future whether adopted or LTFC. I again found her analysis to be helpful when looking at the options.

We promised each other to always live in each other's heart. It is worth mentioning that although our last two weeks were 100% child led, E chose to do a lot of activities with her class because she felt safe and strong enough.

Before, despite our sincere efforts to have the best possible relationship with her, our anxious reactions to her anxiety were ruining every now and then what had been achieved so far.

I am convinced that if we had known more about the therapeutic approach and had been using it since the beginning of the year, we would have been able to avoid a lot of crisis and extreme situations. I am very happy to pass on to the next year team who will be working with E our observations, examples of good practices, even language we used to promote calm and connected state of her mind.

You never made me feel judged, criticized, but rather I was looking forward to your visits as every time you were showing us in practice what the theory that we had read means. Probably the best example of this was when you helped us to do anxiety mapping. I didn't know where to start but you helped us understand how to do that and the following day we already used this method and the conclusions from the day before to avoid a potential escalation of negative emotions. It was also lovely to see your interactions with the child and yet you never undermined our role or methods in front of her.

I wish more professionals can receive the training we had with you because, as one of the documents I read said: good relationships have a healing power. And children after trauma absolutely deserve that healing opportunity.

I wish you all the best. Keep on the good work you're doing, S!
